

ELEVATING LIFT SAFETY STANDARDS

Lifts are indispensable amenities that bring great convenience and efficiency to residents. To ensure compliance with codes and standards, lifts which have been in operation for less than 18 years from the Lift Enhancement Programme's (LEP) commencement date will soon be upgraded with improved safety features.

Under the LEP funded by the Housing Development Board, 80 lifts in Holland-Bukit Panjang Town will be installed with measures to enhance safety performance while 864 lifts will also be progressively equipped with new safety components over the next 10 years.

These steps taken to modernise lifts will take about two weeks each to complete, with a lift surveillance system also on schedule to be implemented. Residents can look forward to the upgraded lifts with heightened safety, providing greater assurance for all.



Modern safety features will include



Slack-stop safety device

Stops lift from moving when governor rope starts to slack



Safety light curtains

Provides sensory input that holds lift doors fully open while passengers enter and exit to reduce possibility of contact and injury



Overspeed protection with braking function

Monitors lift car's speed, detects uncontrolled movement and slows lift car to a safe stop



Interlocking switch for lift door panels

Ensures lift stops moving immediately and remain in position whenever lift door panels are open



Door movement sensor

Detects and stops lift car from moving when doors are not properly closed



Safety barrier

A vertical panel will extend downwards from the lift car entrance to prevent passengers from falling into the lift shaft if doors are opened above the levelling position

Features already in place



Emergency communication bell

Allows lift passengers to alert the relevant personnel who can deploy the emergency response team



Battery-powered automatic rescue device

Brings affected lift to the nearest landing and opens doors for residents to make a safe exit in the event of power failure




SINGAPORE WORLD WOTER DAY ODLIR
